- H.R. 5902 (Conducting Legally Efficient Administration and Resolution of Patents) and
- S.2891 (Restoring the American Invents Act),
- H.R. 5874 (Restoring America's Leadership in Innovation Act),
- the old S.2082 (Stronger Patents Act of 2019) (which is expected to be represented in some form soon)
- as well as the upcoming hearings on Kathi Vidal as next Director.

ARE Law partners Co-Chair Charley Macedo of the PTAB Committee and Co-Chair Anthony Lo Cicero from the LAC Committee will be leading the discussion.

The PTAB Committee will also be soliciting comments from attendees regarding potential comments to submit on S.2891.
